33rd Annual Field Recording Workshop San Francisco State University Field Campus, Yuba Pass Friday June 23 - Sunday June 25, 2017

Spend a weekend in the field recording the rich environment of the Sierra Nevada and learning from expert speakers and hands-on workshop sessions. Lodging is in tent cabins or your own tent or camper, all meals provided.

Presentations will include Jim Metzner, producer of the award-winning Pulse of the Planet radio series and podcast, Alan Krakauer from U.C. Davis on his recording and analysis of the Greater Sage Grouse, Mauricio Schrader, birding by ear instructor, and a panel on adopting a park chaired by Steve Sergeant, producer of the WildeBeat podcast series.

We will record in at least four field locations including wetlands, meadows, and alpine forest.

Workshops include *Microphone Directivity* where we compare different microphone directional patterns and different stereo arrays, and *Make Your Own Windscreen*, with supplies provided to build an economical version of this essential field recording tool.
