

38th Annual Field Recording Workshop Friday-Sunday, June 21-23, 2024 San Francisco State University Field Campus, Yuba Pass, CA





This workshop will be held at the Sierra Nevada Field Campus of San Francisco State University, beside the scenic north fork of the Yuba River. Participants will learn recording techniques hands-on in the field, visiting Sierra Nevada Mountains soundscapes in marsh, meadow, and forest.

The workshop will start earlier than previous years, at 1:00 PM Friday afternoon, and conclude at 1:00 PM Sunday.

There will be intensive one-on-one instruction with a variety of equipment and field techniques as well as lectures, and the opportunity to meet people with backgrounds in a variety of different professions.

The event will offer informative lectures and field trips by experienced sound recordists including:

- Microphone Array Comparison
- Build your own windscreen
- Adopt-a-Park round table discussion

Audio Engineers Dan Dugan, Mark Lipman, Steve Sergeant, and Greg Weddig, who have "adopted" national and local parks, will discuss how cooperating with park research programs provides opportunities to make recordings with both scientific and artistic value.

The cost for the Workshop is \$495.00 which includes platform tent lodging, all meals, and a year's membership. Recording equipment will be provided for those without.
